Church Opening Rota

Two people need to be present in the church when it is open. Please see the wardens or Fr Kevin if this is something you could help with.

A Candle in Memory

Last year we introduced Seven-day memorial candles, that burn in memory of a family or loved one, to the All Soul's Day Mass at St Katharine. A card with the name of the person or family is placed next to the candle which remains lit for a week. As we need to order the candles, please sign the list at the back of church as soon as possible if you would like one. A small charge of £5 is made to cover the cost of the candle, and money can be given to Fr Kevin or Margaret Prestwood. This year's service is on **Thursday the 2nd of November at 7pm at St Katharine**.
